Charges for Naturopathic Appointments - Naturopathic doctor consultations are based mostly on an per hour rate. Depending on the time spent with the ND, a sufferer might pay between \$35 and \$180. The CAND payment schedule is based on a rate of \$125 to \$180 per hour. Initial visits are approximately 1-1Ä?½ hours long with following visits starting from 20 to 60 minutes.
